



What to Know About WIC

Who can get support?

- Moms
- Pregnant women
- Dads
- Grandparents
- Foster parents
- Step-parents
- Guardians
- Caregivers with a low to medium income and those who are part of other programs such as foster care, medical assistance, or SNAP are eligible.

Did you know?

Even if you don't qualify for SNAP (EBT, Food Stamps), or Medicaid, you still may qualify for WIC. **Many families are eligible for WIC and don't realize it.**

What's the retail value?

For women and children the retail value of the healthy food WIC provides is ~\$74 per person per month.

For infants, WIC promotes breastfeeding, and provides formula when requested. The value of the formula is ~\$180 per month.
